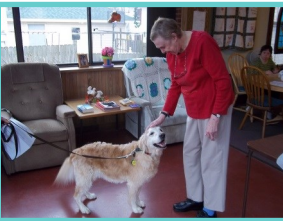


## Adult Day Happenings

- \* Had a Chinese New Years Party



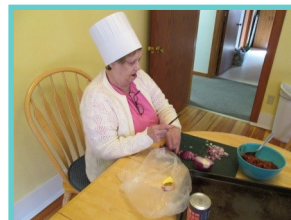
### February 2014

- \* Therese has started a Culinary Cooking Class on Thursday Afternoons. It been very successful and they clients really enjoy it!

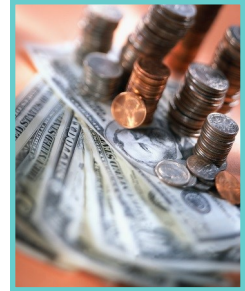


## Property Tax and Rent Reimbursement Credits

Senior Resources will assist with Property Tax and Rent Reimbursement forms again this year. To qualify for this program you must be 65 or older, or totally disabled and 18 or older.

Income limits apply. Household income includes social security, wages, pension and interest income. If you receive in-kind assistance or title 19 benefits they would also be included as income.

## Advance Care Planning

What if you had an injury or illness that left you unable to communicate? How would you tell others your wishes about your healthcare? Would your family or friends know what kind of healthcare you would want?

Honoring Your Wishes is a community-wide program that will help you create an advance care plan. Advance care planning is a way for you to talk about your future healthcare goals. You will then make a written plan that will describe your wishes to others if you cannot communicate.
