We would like to give a big “THANK YOU” to our current SHIIP (Senior Health Insurance Information Program) volunteers for all the time and commitment they put in to helping area seniors through the open enrollment period for Medicare Part D. Open enrollment is from October 15 through December 7.

Volunteer SHIIP Counselors spent many hours doing prescription drug comparisons, guiding seniors through the Medicare enrollment process and helping them with many of their Medicare issues.

This year two of our counselors tracked the amounts they saved their clients. The total saved for 68 clients was \$69,851 (yearly). The average each of those clients saved was \$1,027 per year.

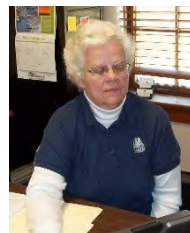
The seniors were very appreciative of the help they received from the trained counselors during open enrollment and throughout the year. They have peace of mind knowing someone is there to help.
